Historic Perspective

In 1914, Dr. Winette Orr, a surgeon at an orthopedic hospital, and his wife invited friends to dancing parties at the hospital. In 1916, the group selected Faculty Dance Club as its name and became a formal organization in 1923-24. Until the mid-1920s, tuxedos were occasionally the dress for a dance. Costume parties also were popular during the Club's first fifty years. In the early years, dances were held in a variety of places on and off campus. Dances now are held almost exclusively in the East Campus Union. Except for the December holiday dance, today's attire is more informal, although skirts and jackets often are worn. Live bands continue to be a trademark at the Club's dances each year. Everyone from the general community is welcome to join and dance with the UNL Faculty Dance Club. Join us!

Reservations Required

Dance only, or for Dinner & Dance: reservations or cancellations are accepted until the RSVP deadline (the venue requires a tally 10 days prior to each dance). Meals will cost approximately \$25/person. **The club will be charged for your meals even if you are unable to attend.** Please arrange to send payment to our Treasurers if you find you need to cancel after the deadline.

Guest Policy

All dancers are welcome! For non-member dancers we have a dance only fee. Meal costs are in addition to dues or dance only admission. Non-member dance admission is \$35/couple or \$17.50/person. Guests who have paid their entry fee for any given dance may upgrade to full yearly membership by paying the balance of membership dues.

Bring Treats, Plan a Dance

Dance sponsors decorate the tables and supply chocolates for a dance of their choice. Sponsors remove their decorations after the dance (so the club doesn't incur a cleaning fee). Just let the presidents know in advance which dance you'd like to sponsor, and have fun!
